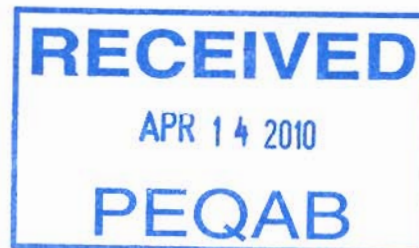

Dear Dr. Ross:

In a letter dated December 9, 2009, I advised Algoma University that pursuant to subsection 4(1) of the *Post-secondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000*, it was my intent to grant consent to Algoma University to advertise and offer in Ontario one honorary doctorate degree per calendar year from the following list of possible honorary degree options:

- Doctor of Letters (honoris causa) – Hon. D.Litt.
- Doctor of Laws (honoris causa) – Hon. LL.D.
- Doctor of Science (honoris causa) – Hon. D.Sc.
- Doctor of Music (honoris causa) – Hon. D.Mus.
- Doctor of Fine Arts (honoris causa) – Hon. DFA
- Doctor of Business Administration (honoris causa) – Hon. DBA
- Doctor of Social Work (honoris causa) – Hon. DSW

and to hold itself out as a university in relation to activities authorized by this consent.

The intent to grant consent was subject to Algoma University accepting the terms and conditions set out in the letter of intent which included the Standard Terms and Conditions for a public institution. The letter also indicated that the consent would commence from the date of written confirmation from the Minister that Algoma University had satisfied the requirements for a consent.

I would like to confirm that I have received and am satisfied with the signed Applicant Agreement Form and the requirements for a consent as noted in the December 9, 2009 letter.


