Dear Dr. Meyenn,

In a letter dated August 19, 2010, I advised Charles Sturt University that, pursuant to subsection 4(1) of the *Post-Secondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000*, it was my intent to grant a consent to Charles Sturt University to advertise and offer in Ontario a Bachelor of Business Administration (Accounting) program, and to hold itself out as a university and be known by the name of Charles Sturt University in Ontario in connection with this program.

The intent to grant consent was subject to Charles Sturt University accepting the terms and conditions set out in the letter of intent which included the Standard Terms and Conditions for a public institution. The letter also indicated that the consent would be for a period of five years, commencing from the date of my written confirmation that Charles Sturt University had satisfied the requirements for a consent.

I would like to confirm that I have received and am satisfied with the signed Applicant Agreement Form and the requirements for a consent as noted in the August 19, 2010, letter. I am pleased to advise you that I am granting consent to Charles Sturt University to advertise and offer in Ontario a Bachelor of Business Administration (Accounting) program, and to hold itself out as a university and be known by the name of Charles Sturt University in Ontario in connection with this program.

The consent is specific to the campus located at the Bay Area Learning Centre, 860 Harrington Court, Burlington, Ontario, L7N 3N4, and is for a period of five years from the date of this letter of consent. The consent is subject to the terms and conditions identified in the letter dated August 19, 2010, and its attachment. Charles Sturt University has also confirmed its commitment to seek accreditation with the Certified General Accountants of Ontario (CGA) as soon as the program becomes eligible for accreditation. Upon achieving accreditation, Charles Sturt University will submit a copy of a letter from the CGA, confirming that the Bachelor of Business
