Re: Application from Conestoga College Institute of Technology and Advanced Learning for consent to change the name of its Bachelor of Applied Human Services (Community and Criminal Justice) to Bachelor of Community and Criminal Justice: Recommendation to Grant Consent

In accordance with the streamlined process for the review of nomenclature changes, Conestoga College submitted a request to change the name of its Bachelor of Applied Human Services (Community and Criminal Justice) to Bachelor of Community and Criminal Justice to the Board on June 28th, 2010. At its meeting of July 19th, 2010 the Board reviewed and gave final consideration to Conestoga's request.

Based on:

- the applicant's request;
- the Board's standard and benchmarks for nomenclature; and
- the Board's assessment of the information,

the Board finds that the proposed nomenclature meets the Board's requirements and recommends that you grant consent to Conestoga College Institute of Technology and Advanced Learning to change the name of its Bachelor of Applied Human Services (Community and Criminal Justice) to Bachelor of Community and Criminal Justice.

It is common practice, in circumstances where program nomenclature has changed without any associated change in program content, to offer former graduates of the program a new testamur that reflects the new nomenclature. The Board recommends that former graduates of this program who wish to receive a replacement testamur with the new nomenclature have

the opportunity to do so, on the condition that the original testamur be returned, and the replacement indicate the year of original graduation.
