I am pleased to advise you that, pursuant to subsection 4(1) of the *Post-secondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000* (the Act), it is my intent to amend the consent granted to Conestoga College Institute of Technology and Advanced Learning to change the name of the following programs:

The amendments to the consents are subject to the further terms and conditions set out below:

2. The college maintains conformity with all commitments made in writing by the college to the Minister or the Postsecondary Education Quality Assessment Board (the Board) as part of the application dated June 30, 2010, for a change to the nomenclature of the above-listed programs and any additional commitments made in writing by the college during the Board's review process.






