1. This intent to amend consent letter is returned to me within 30 business days of the date of this letter, signed by a representative of the college authorized to bind the organization.
2. The college maintains conformity with all commitments made in writing by the college to the Minister or the Postsecondary Education Quality Assessment Board (the Board) as part of the application dated June 28, 2010, for a change to the nomenclature of the above-listed programs and any additional commitments made in writing by the college during the Board's review process.
3. With respect to the Bachelor of Engineering (Mechanical Systems Engineering) program, only students graduating after September, 2010, the date the program was accredited by Engineers Canada, will be able to receive a testamur with the new nomenclature.


