**Re: Application from Georgian College Institute of Applied Arts and Technology for consent to change the name of its Bachelor of Applied Business (Automotive Management) to Bachelor of Business (Automotive Management): Recommendation to Grant Consent**

In accordance with the streamlined process for the review of requests for nomenclature changes to degrees in applied areas of study offered by colleges of applied arts and technology, Georgian College submitted a request to change the name of its Bachelor of Applied Business (Automotive Management) to Bachelor of Business (Automotive Management) to the Board on December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2009. At its meeting of January 19<sup>th</sup>, the Board reviewed and gave final consideration to Georgian's request.

Based on:

- the applicant's request;
- the Board's assessment of the information; and
- the Board's standards and benchmarks for nomenclature;

the Board finds that the proposed nomenclature meets the Board's requirements and recommends that you grant consent to Georgian College Institute of Applied Arts and Technology to change the name of its Bachelor of Applied Business (Automotive Management) to Bachelor of Business (Automotive Management).

It is common practice, in circumstances where program nomenclature has changed without any associated change in program content, to offer former graduates of the program a new testamur that reflects the new nomenclature. The Board recommends that former graduates of

this program who wish to receive a replacement testamur with the new nomenclature have the opportunity to do so, on the condition that the original testamur be returned, and the replacement indicate the year of original graduation.
