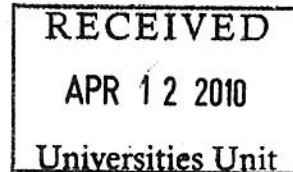

I am pleased to advise you that, pursuant to subsection 4(1) of the *Post-secondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000* (the Act), it is my intent to amend the consent granted to Georgian College of Applied Arts and Technology to change the name of the following programs:

All other terms and conditions of the original consents relating to the delivery of the above-noted programs, as identified in the original letters of consent dated November 19, 2008, December 31, 2007 and December 14, 2007 respectively, remain in force. In this regard, note that the term of the consent remains unchanged, and the consent is specific to the site at One Georgian Drive, Barrie, Ontario.

The amendments to the consents are subject to the further terms and conditions set out below:

1. This consent letter is returned to me within 30 business days of the date of this letter, signed by a representative of the college authorized to bind the organization.
2. The college maintains conformity with all commitments made in writing by the college to the Minister or the Postsecondary Education Quality Assessment Board (the Board) as part of the application dated December 19, 2009, for a change to the nomenclature of the above-listed programs and any additional commitments made in writing by the college during the Board's review process.


