Dear Mr. Beltzner:

I am writing further to my letter of August 18, 2011, advising you that pursuant to Section 4 of the *Post-secondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000*, it was my intent to grant consent to Humber College Institute of Technology and Advanced Learning to advertise and offer a Bachelor of International Development program in Ontario.

As I indicated in my letter, my intent to grant consent was subject to the college accepting the terms and conditions set out in my letter which included the Standard Terms and Conditions for a College of Applied Arts and Technology and the following additional conditions:

1. The consent is specific to the **Humber Lakeshore Campus at 3199 Lakeshore Boulevard West, Toronto, ON.**
2. The college shall use the nomenclature **Bachelor of International Development** for this program.
3. The college shall maintain the program's conformity with all the criteria set out in the handbook of the Postsecondary Education Quality Assessment Board titled *Handbook for Ontario Colleges 2010*.
4. The college shall, as per its commitments made during the course of the application review:
 - Hire two full-time faculty members with PhDs in international development or one of its related fields by year three of program delivery;
 - Continue to provide faculty with opportunities to attend conferences, present papers and produce some scholarly work to build academic capacity; and
 - Consider the suggestions made by the Quality Assessment Panel regarding curricular modifications.


