

## **Section 1: Program Abstract**

Humber's Interior Design degree curriculum balances theory with creative problem solving with research, practical skills, and technology. A focus on sustainable design is integrated throughout the program in many subject areas, emphasized in interior design studios. Interior design classes are enhanced by a breadth of liberal arts and applied science courses. Collaborative and stimulating interior design studios enable students to master the design process and their presentation abilities, and later to acquire vital professional practice skills.

In 2000, the Humber Interior Design diploma program was first in Ontario to receive professional accreditation by the Council for Interior Design Accreditation (CIDA). In 2007, CIDA granted the degree program professional accreditation for a six-year period and the program was reviewed by CIDA in November 2010 as part of the accreditation renewal process.
