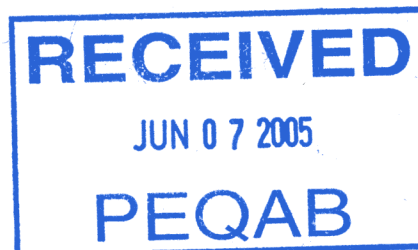

Dear Dr. Rose:

I am writing further to my letter of November 30, 2004 advising that pursuant to subsection 4(1) of the *Post-secondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000*, it was my intent to grant consent to Niagara University to offer and to advertise the Master of Science in Education (Administration and Supervision) degree in Ontario and to hold itself out as a university and be known by the name of Niagara University.

As I indicated in my letter, my intent to grant consent was subject to the university accepting the terms and conditions set out in my letter, which included the Standard Terms and Conditions attached to the letter, the execution of the Applicant Agreement form, satisfactory completion of the tuition fee, financial security and trust fund forms attached to the Standard Terms and Conditions and fulfilling of the security requirements as required under the legislation.

Pursuant to my letter, the consent would be for a period of five years, commencing on the date of my written confirmation that I am satisfied with the above-noted requirements.

I would like to confirm that I have received and am satisfied with the signed Applicant Agreement form as well as the transcript and security arrangements. I also note that the university is not required to set up a trust fund at this time.

I am pleased to advise you that I am confirming I have granted my consent to Niagara University to advertise and offer in Ontario a Master of Science in Education (Administration and Supervision) in Ontario and to hold itself out as a university and be known by the name of Niagara University. This consent is for a period of five years commencing from the date of this letter and is subject to the terms and conditions identified in my letter of November 30, 2004 and its attachments.
