I am pleased to advise you that, pursuant to subsection 4(1) of the *Post-secondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000* (the Act), it is my intent to amend the consent granted to Seneca College of Applied Arts and Technology to change the name of the following program:

Bachelor of Applied Technology (Flight)	Bachelor of Aviation Technology

All other terms and conditions of the original consent relating to the delivery of the above-noted program, as identified in the original letter of consent dated September 8, 2008, remain in force. In this regard, please note that the duration of the consent remains unchanged.

The amendment to the consent is subject to the further terms and conditions set out below:

1. This intent to amend consent letter is returned to me within 30 business days of the date of this letter, signed by a representative of the college authorized to bind the organization.
2. The college maintains conformity with all commitments made in writing by the college to the Minister or the Postsecondary Education Quality Assessment Board (the Board) as part of the application dated July 13, 2010, for a change to the nomenclature of the above-listed program and any additional commitments made in writing by the college during the Board's review process.

The above-noted amendment to the consent is effective as of the date I receive the sign back of this letter. Ministry staff will provide the college with confirmation in writing of the date of receipt of the sign-back letter.

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Please note that if former graduates of this program wish to receive a replacement testamur with the new nomenclature, they may do so on the condition that the original testamur be returned and the replacement indicates the year of the original graduation date.


