### **Program Abstract**

The Bachelor of Commerce – International Accounting and Finance program was designed to give students knowledge and skills of both a theoretical and practical nature to prepare them to work in the areas of accounting and finance within the Canadian and global business environment.

As evident in the learning outcomes, the development of students' transferable skills is a key component of this program, skills in communication, critical/analytical thinking, numeracy, business technology, and teamwork. Also, the development of information literacy and research skills is an important element of the program.

Students will be able to work in the areas of accounting and finance in large or medium sized enterprises, and in the public or non-profit sectors.

The program is recognized by the three Canadian professional accounting bodies and receives the maximum credit allowable towards their designations: Chartered Accountant, Certified Management Accountant, and Certified General Accountant. Students are encouraged to complete at least one designation after graduating from this program.

Students may also go on to further academic study and obtain a Masters of Business Administration or Master of Arts/Master of Science in Accounting at any of the universities with which Seneca has agreements. The degree is recognized by, for example, Centenary College, Davenport University, University of Canada West, University College of Cape Breton, Memorial University and Royal Roads University.
