requesting a teach-out of its Bachelor of Applied

Recommendation to Grant Consent**

Pursuant to section 5(1) of the *Post-secondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000*, on September 28, 2007, St. Clair College of Applied Arts and Technology applied to the Minister of Training, Colleges and Universities for consent to teach-out its Bachelor of Applied Technology (Industrial Management) program, the consent for which is due to expire on August 13, 2008.

In accordance with section 5.2 of the *Act*, the application was referred on December 11, 2007, to the Board for its review and recommendation. The Board reviewed the application in accordance with its *Handbook for CAAT Renewals, May, 2006*, and gave final consideration to the application at its meeting of June 24, 2008.

- the additional material submitted by the applicant, and
- the Board's assessment of the information against the Board's standards and benchmarks for a bachelor degree in an applied area of study,

the Postsecondary Education Quality Assessment Board recommends that you grant consent to St. Clair College of Applied Arts and Technology to continue to offer a Bachelor of Applied Technology (Industrial Management) program, abbreviated B.A.T., at its Windsor South Campus, the current consent for which expires on August 13, 2008, until September 1, 2010, by which time the last of the current students are scheduled to have completed the program,
