Dear Dr. Davey:

In a letter dated December 22, 2006, the former Minister advised Tyndale University College & Seminary that pursuant to subsection 4(1) of the *Post-secondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000*, it was his intent to grant consent to Tyndale to advertise and offer a Bachelor of Education (Primary/Junior and Junior/Intermediate) in Ontario.

The intent to grant consent was subject to Tyndale accepting the terms and conditions set out in the letter of intent which included the Standard Terms and Conditions for a private institution. The letter also indicated that the consent would be for a period of five years, commencing from the date of written confirmation from the Minister that Tyndale had satisfied the requirements for consent.

I would like to confirm that the ministry has received all requirements for consent as noted in the December 22<sup>nd</sup> letter, including a copy of the letter to Tyndale from the Ontario College of Teachers (OCT) informing it that the program "substantially satisfies the requirements of *Regulation 347/02, Accreditation of Teacher Education Programs*", and granting initial accreditation to Tyndale subject to additional conditions. OCT requires Tyndale to submit the following additional information acceptable to the Accreditation Committee:

- the course content for each of the required courses in the Content Strand of the program, such as course outlines;
- the qualifications and experience of the full-time and part-time faculty hired to teach the program, such as faculty academic profiles; and
- a functioning TEAC with an advisory or liaison capacity to the program, such as minutes of the meeting.

Further to these additional conditions, OCT requires Tyndale to:

- submit a plan to the Accreditation Committee within six months after receiving the decision, outlining proposed methods and estimated time for satisfying the conditions; and
- report annually to the Accreditation Committee on the progress in satisfying the conditions.


Initial accreditation is granted subject to the conditions noted above for a period of two years (May 31, 2009) or the period of time ending on the graduation of the second class of students enrolled in the program, whichever is the longer period of time, not to exceed three years (May 31, 2010).

I am pleased to advise you that subject to Tyndale confirming in writing to me that it will comply with OCT's condition within 30 business days of the date of this letter, I am granting consent to Tyndale University College to advertise and offer in Ontario a Bachelor of Education (Primary/Junior and Junior/Intermediate).

The consent is specific to the location noted in the letter of intent to grant consent, and is for a period of five years from the date of my receipt of Tyndale's letter of confirmation. The consent is subject to the terms and conditions identified in the letter of intent to grant consent dated December 22, 2006 and its attachment; to Tyndale complying with the conditions imposed by OCT; and to Tyndale maintaining its OCT accreditation for the Bachelor of Education (Primary/Junior and Junior/Intermediate) for the period of the consent.

I would like to take this opportunity to wish Tyndale University College & Seminary well in offering this program.
