Dear Dr. Campbell:

I am pleased to advise you that, pursuant to subsection 4(1) of the *Post-secondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000* (the Act), it is my intent to amend the University of New Brunswick's current consent with respect to the granting of honorary degrees in Ontario to allow the University of New Brunswick to present, for one time only, five honorary degrees at a special ceremony in Toronto on September 23, 2010 at the Royal Conservatory of Music, in celebration of the University of New Brunswick's 225th anniversary.

At present, the University of New Brunswick has a consent from the Minister of Training, Colleges and Universities to grant up to a maximum of one honorary degree per year for each program for which the University has a Minister's consent to offer in Ontario. The University of New Brunswick currently has a Ministerial consent to offer one degree program in Ontario, a Bachelor of Nursing program and, as a result, can confer one honorary degree per year in Ontario.

The amendment to the consent is subject to the further terms and conditions set out below:

1. This consent letter is returned to me within 30 business days of the date of this letter, signed by a representative of the University of New Brunswick authorized to bind the organization.
2. The University of New Brunswick maintains conformity with all commitments made in writing by the University of New Brunswick to the Minister or the Postsecondary Education Quality Assessment Board (the Board) as part of the application dated June 9, 2010 for an amendment to permit a one-time-only granting of five honorary degrees in Ontario on September 23, 2010.


All other terms and conditions of the original consent relating to the granting of honorary degrees, as identified in the original letter of consent dated June 22, 2006, remain in force.
