Dear Dr. Secco:

In a letter dated June 19, 2009, I advised the University of New Brunswick that pursuant to subsection 4(1) of the *Post-secondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000*, it was my intent to grant consent to the University of New Brunswick to continue to offer the degree completion component of its Bachelor of Nursing program in Ontario until May 31, 2015, and to hold itself out as a university and be known in Ontario by the name of University of New Brunswick in relation to this program. The letter also states that the consent is for the sole purpose of teaching out students currently enrolled in the program, since the program is being phased out in Ontario.

The intent to grant consent was subject to the University of New Brunswick accepting the terms and conditions set out in the letter of intent which included the Standard Terms and Conditions for a public institution as well as the following additional terms and conditions:

1. The Applicant Agreement form set out as Attachment A of the Standard Terms and Conditions is signed by an authorized representative of the institution and submitted to me within 30 business days of the date of this letter.
2. The following information relating to student transcripts is provided to me in writing:
  - ▶ the location where the institution will maintain the transcripts for the programs;
  - ▶ the medium for maintaining the transcripts;
  - ▶ the information to be included in the transcripts;
  - ▶ the name and contact information of the Registrar or other individual responsible for maintaining transcripts; and
  - ▶ the name and contact information of the third party to be the off-site record keeper.

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3. The consent is specific to the campus located at 205 Humber College Blvd., Toronto, Ontario M9W 5L7 on the campus of Humber College Institute of Technology & Advanced Learning.
4. Information on the progress of the remaining cohorts of students through the program is to be included in the university's annual report to me demonstrating that these students are progressing in the time allotted.

The letter also indicated that the consent would run until May 31, 2015, commencing from the date of written confirmation from the Minister that the University of New Brunswick has satisfied the requirements for consent.


I would like to confirm that I have received the signed Applicant Agreement Form and am satisfied that the University of New Brunswick has met the terms and conditions for consent as noted in the June 19, 2009 letter. Please note, however, that ministry staff are currently preparing recommendations for my consideration regarding criteria for approving off-site/third-party transcript maintenance arrangements under the *Postsecondary Education Choice and Excellence Act, 2000*. Pending the outcome of this review, any application for renewal of consent, or any application for another program, may be subject to additional requirements with respect to the administration of the student protection provisions under the PSECE Act.

I am pleased to advise you that I am granting consent to the University of New Brunswick to advertise and offer the degree completion component of the Bachelor of Nursing program in Ontario and to hold itself out as a university in relation to activities authorized by this consent and be known in Ontario by the name of University of New Brunswick in regard to this program.

The consent is specific to the location identified in the letter of intent to grant consent and runs until May 31, 2009 from the date of the letter of consent. The consent is subject to the terms and conditions identified in the letter of intent to grant consent dated June 19, 2009 and its attachment.

I would like to take this opportunity to wish the University of New Brunswick well as it teaches out students in this program.
